The Derek Lendosky Memorial Scholarship is given annually, in memory of Derek Lendosky, who left us just 3 days before his 10th birthday in a tragic accident. Derek was a very loving and caring child whose spirit is living on through a foundation set up in his name that awards scholarships and does community projects to help change or better the lives of people in our community. It is the foundation's hope that Derek will continue to be able to help individuals for years to come.

The purpose of this scholarship is to give, at minimum, 2 scholarships, to deserving graduating Seniors from the Fennimore and Iowa-Grant school districts, and up to 2 additional scholarships to those school districts or to other qualifying graduating Seniors who turn in a completed application. Applications are due by May 1st of the current year, and will be evaluated by the Lendosky Family for consideration to be awarded in that year at graduation.

The intent of the scholarship is to reward a graduating senior who has excelled in their education, has participated in sports, and has done volunteer work or helped others by volunteering or paying it forward.
